Scope of Project:

SMS provides ongoing access and sentry services to the Esperance Port Authority (EPA).

SMS was contracted in January and April of 2015 to conduct Conveyor Refurbishment works for EPA. This project had two major pre-requisites:

- * The limitations of the structure only allowed for a scaffold dead weight of 400kg per linear metre; and
- * The structure had to be craneable due to time and weather constraints.

SMS engineered a craneable alloy scaffold comprising of three Pcs.

Personnel resourcing includes supply of scaffold labour, supervision, equipment and vehicles during all planned shutdowns and emergency break-downs
