

<p>Project Overview:</p>	<p>Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers are focused on the development of the world's largest steam urea plant with a production capacity of 2 MTPA. The plant is located within the Burrup Strategic Industrial Area, Burrup Peninsula, approximately 10km from Dampier and 20km north-west of Karratha on the north west coastline of Western Australia. The development will utilise local natural gas for fertiliser production, using innovative and low-emissions technologies and will be Australia's first Urea Export Project generating Export Revenue of US\$ 800 Million/year. The facility will consist of a Syngas Production Block, Fertiliser Production Block and Offsite Facilities and Utilities.</p>
