Package Description	<p>Background: Woodside Energy Ltd (‘Woodside’), is issuing a Request for Information to support its assessment of the supply market for forklift hire and maintenance for Woodside’s Australian operations based in Dampier, Western Australia.</p> <p>General Scope of Works: The scope of services is generally described as the supply and maintenance of Woodside’s forklift fleet on a rental basis across three operating plants on the Burrup Peninsula:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ King Bay Supply Base (KBSB) ✓ Karratha Gas Plant (KGP) ✓ Pluto LNG Plant (Pluto) <p>The core fleet is comprised of approximately 40 forklifts of various capacity and in addition to the core fleet, KGP and Pluto sometimes require forklifts on an ad-hoc basis to meet operational demands.</p> <p>Contractor shall provide and deliver the forklifts in accordance with Company’s specifications and any other requirements of the Contract. In addition, Contractor shall provide all labour, parts, materials, tools, equipment, testing equipment, transport and services as required to provide an all-inclusive professional maintenance program (both preventative and reactive) for the forklifts.</p> <p>Contractors who are selected to formally participate in Company issued EOI will be required to confirm:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Availability for a site visit to Woodside’s Burrup facilities - Could Woodside representatives visit contractor’s site to better understand contractor’s capability and operations? - Does contractor have the capacity to allow Woodside representatives to test drive a small range of forklifts? - Is contractor subscribed to ISNetworld which will enable Woodside to perform a detailed health, safety and environment audit on contractor’s process? - How would contractor create local participation and/or local employment opportunities in support of Woodside’s Burrup Hub vision?
