Scope of Work

Provision of Medical Services, including supply and delivery of an Intensive Care Paramedical service to support the Company Helicopter Service provider.

This service will be based in Company's Helicopter Service provider facilities in Darwin.

The Helicopter Service provider will be utilising twin engine, offshore rated helicopters, which will be configured by the Helicopter Service provider for medivac, winch capability and search and rescue.

The Intensive Care Paramedic (ICP) must be an Advanced Clinical Practitioner in Paramedicine (who is registered with Paramedics Australia), with a bachelor's degree in health science and with a minimum of 5 years' experience. The ICP shall provide medical assessment, treatment and care in the offshore out-of-hospital environment for acutely unwell patients with significant illness or injury.

The Intensive Care Paramedic shall have previous experience in offshore oil and gas projects in Australia and have winching experience or be winch trained.

This service shall support the Barossa Project 24/7 and delivered to multiple offshore vessels through Project drilling, construction and Floating Production Storage Offtake (FPSO) vessel hook up and commissioning.

Company will provide the following;

- a) Dedicated, signposted and lockable medical room for the ICP sole use, with the following inclusions;
  - Lockable safe bolted to the floor for scheduled drugs;
  - Locked door to the room, with security bars and screens on any windows;
  - Lockable fridge for medicines;
  - Office desk and chair;
  - Phone with landline, wi-fi access, printer and internet connectivity;
  - Lockable filing cabinet, shelving and storage cupboard for consumables;
  - Suitable outside signage;
  - Small table for calibration of equipment;
- b) Use of staff rest area/kitchen and other facilities;
- c) A wheelchair for patient transfer;
- d) Medically approved stretchers to conduct at minimum, two patient medivacs;
- e) Cradles and storage areas for onboard storage and securing of ICP medical equipment whilst in transit in the helicopter; and
- f) Helicopter transfers from the helicopter operator's base in Darwin to the offshore vessel for medivac retrieval.

Vessels will be in the Barossa Project Site footprint approximately 300km offshore North-Northwest of Darwin, Northern Territory, within the Bonaparte Basin, located in the Timor Sea, with medivac from these vessels by either helideck landings or winching.
