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## Scope

Score Marine Australia are seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) to supply BAE Systems Australia Ltd / ASC Shipbuilding Pty Ltd with valves and associated equipment for the Hunter Class Frigate Program (HCFP).

Score Marine, as main supplier to the British Type 26 Global Combat Ship, is seeking to establish the feasibility of partnering with Australian capability in order to maximise local content.

The purpose of the following capability questionnaire is to determine industry capability and the viability of a partnering arrangement to provide valves and associated equipment to the HCFP.

The Hunter Class Frigates will be built at the ASC Shipbuilding facility at Osborne, Adelaide, South Australia.

### **Suppliers will be required to supply Hydrant Valves with the below specifications:**

- The scope of supply is for various different types and sizes of Hydrant Valves for use on the Hunter Class - Global Combat Ship
- The following are the main types of Hydrant Valves to be supplied:
  - 87 off Hydrant Valves
  - Valve Nominal Size DN 50
  - Pressure Class PN 16
  - Body Materials: Nickel Aluminium Bronze
- The valves shall be in accordance with Lloyd's Register Rules and Regulations for the Classification of Naval Ships.
- The Supplies shall be Type Approved for use for the intended application on Naval Ships, in accordance with Lloyd's Register Rules and Regulations for the Classification of Naval Ships.
