

Anglo American – Aquila Project Expression of Interest (EOI) **UME001 - Longwall Shields and Pans**

General Description

The objective of the Aquila Project (the Project) is to convert the previous Aquila bord and pillar mine, located at the Capcoal mining complex in Central Queensland's Bowen Basin, to a longwall operation.

The scope of the Project includes:

- Modification of existing Grasstree development system to support longwall operations;
- Modification of existing Grasstree mobile equipment fleet;
- Removal, modification and replacement of existing underground conveyor system;
- Construction of a surface material handling system; and
- Limited upgrade to the site services, including electrical, controls and water systems to support the new longwall operations.

Expressions of Interest

Anglo American encourages local businesses interested in Supply of Longwall Shields and AFC Pans to register an expression of interest (EOI) through the ICN Gateway webpage.

Specific Scope Requirements

The scope of work may include:

- Supply of longwall shields for two longwall face sets each with 30,000 cycles estimated life
- One face set will be 370m wide and the second 330m wide
- The planned mining height range of the shield supports should be from 1.9m to 2.2m
- Supply of AFC pans to suit the two face sets.
- Each set of AFC pans to have a life of 20Mt ROM
- The AFC pans to be compatible with the AFC drive heads overhauled in a separate package

Delivery Schedule: It is anticipated that these works will require delivery in Q2 2021
