Project Description	<i>The CCCE project will comprise three key scopes of work, these include:</i> CCCE Essential Works - These comprise of essential maintenance works including roof sheeting replacement, replacement of major mechanical plant, upgrade of electrical services, audio-visual installation replacement and DDA upgrade works. CCCE Refurbishment Works - These include the refurbishment of front of house public spaces, patron amenities, food and beverage facilities and back of house operational areas. CCCE Expansion Works - This includes the provision of new facilities at the Wharf Street end of the Centre including a 450-seat flat floor plenary space, 3 meeting rooms, exhibition space, banquet facility and associated patron facilities and operational spaces that will enable concurrent conventions to occur with-in the centre.
