General Description

The Queensland Government is working to connect businesses across industries with suppliers of essential supplies to continue operations. We have several requests for denatured ethanol to make hand sanitiser, with additional requests expected to follow.

Suppliers who respond here should indicate their:

- immediate capacity and quantity that can be supplied
- immediate timeframes for production and delivery
- any capabilities needed to scale up their capacity, quantities and by what timeframes.

Expressions of Interest

The Queensland Government encourages local businesses interested in supplying denatured ethanol to register an expression of interest (EOI) through the ICN Gateway webpage.

Specific Scope Requirements

As at 9 April 2020, we have the following various requests, with further requests for denatured ethanol likely to follow:

- 2,500 litres of denatured ethanol required immediately and ongoing weekly
- minimum of 12,000 litres of denatured ethanol required immediately and ongoing weekly.

If you are able to provide any amount of denatured ethanol, please express your interest in supplying for this market.
