Project Description	<p>Salini Impregilo, Clough and Lane have formed Future Generation Joint Venture (Future Gen) to provide the EPC package for SHL on the Snowy 2.0 Project.</p> <p>The Project is a pumped hydro project that will increase the generation capacity of the Snowy Mountains Scheme by up to 2,000MW and at full capacity will provide approximately 350,000MW/h of energy storage. The project includes all activities associated with the requirements for the Snowy 2.0 Pumped Hydro-electric Scheme.</p>

The Segment Factory will be located on industrial-zoned land in the south-eastern corner of Polo Flat, an industrial zoned area located to the east of Cooma. The operational facility will contain a concrete batching plant, a warehouse building for the manufacture of precast concrete segments (the precast building), uncovered storage areas for raw material and segments, vehicle parking areas and associated offices and workshops.</p>
