#MakingItForQld – what do you need to be made in Queensland

General Description

The Queensland Government is seeking expressions of interest from companies who currently import goods and services from outside Queensland and are looking for opportunities to buy from Queensland manufacturers.

Information for Potential Suppliers

The COVID-19 pandemic provides many opportunities for Queensland manufacturers to provide goods and services into supply chains impacted by the pandemic by replacing goods and services previously imported from interstate or overseas.

The Queensland Government is encouraging companies who are currently importing goods and services to seek out opportunities to procure these goods and services from Queensland manufacturers.

This pandemic presents an opportunity to bolster domestic manufacturing, particularly in areas where supply chains of Queensland and Australian businesses have been disrupted due to reliance on overseas or interstate importation of raw and manufactured materials and/or goods and services. The aim for Queensland is for the manufacturing sector to scale up, grow and deliver to the community and industry in times of need and into the future, and to build resistance to supply chain disruption as experienced during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Therefore, the Queensland Government is encouraging companies that normally import to consider if they can provide opportunities for Queensland manufacturing facilities to meet future demands.

Expressions of Interest

The Queensland Government encourages businesses to register an expression of interest (EOI) detailing their requirements for raw and manufactured materials and goods and services through the ICN Gateway webpage. This information will be used to match your business with Queensland manufacturers who can deliver into your supply chain for the longer term.

Scope Requirements

This EOI is general in nature and will assist the Queensland Government to match your business' demands with Queensland manufacturers capabilities and capacities.

Your response to this EOI should identify demands for locally manufactured supplies (raw and/or manufactured materials, goods, products and services).

There is another general EOI on the ICN Gateway webpage which will identify manufacturers who you can retool, diversify and scale up to increase manufacturing in Queensland, as well as whether it would be in the immediate and/or longer term.
