

Tanami Expansion 2 (TE 2) Project - EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Project Overview: The Newmont Goldcorp Tanami Operation (NGT) is located in the Tanami Desert of the Northern Territory approximately 530 km north west of Alice Springs. The Brownfields mining operations are located at the Dead Bullock Soak (DBS) area approximately 42 km to the west of the Granites. The nearest settlement is Yuendumu some 250 km southeast of The Granites. The Tanami Expansion 2 (TE 2) Project consists of expanding the mining infrastructure at Newmont Goldcorp Tanami Operations and potential increase of current ore production rate from its current nominal 2.6 Mtpa.

Package Title: **TE2 Process Plant Upgrades Engineering**

Package Description: The Contractor's Scope of Work is for detailed engineering and design services for the expansion of the Granites processing facility to meet the Project requirements and includes provision of technical input into the procurement, construction and commissioning phases.

The Contractor shall be responsible engineering and design of the Facilities as specified including preparation of all drawings, specifications and other documents required for activities to be performed by Contractor, Subcontractors and Vendors to construct, commission and handover the Facilities. The Contractor shall ensure that engineering and design for all systems and subsystems meets the minimum production and performance requirements.

The work shall include, but shall not necessarily be limited to, the following:

- Supply of all off-site and on-site labour, materials and equipment, necessary to complete the works in accordance with all Specifications and Drawings;
- The Contractor is responsible for all things necessary or incidental to the performance of the Services and address the associated risks with a safe system of work;
- The Contractor as a minimum is to demonstrate compliance to NT Acts and Regulations, WA Acts and Regulations and Australian Standards.

The Contractor shall perform the Services at locations as mutually agreed upon between the Contractor and the Principal. Study activities may require several short term business trips to the Site and other locations as authorized by The Principal.

Due to the importance of this project for the Company globally, and in accordance with general

Company requirements, the quality of the engineering deliverables including all design, drawings, specifications and documentation, may be to a higher standard than the Contractor may be used to working with for other clients. Fundamental engineering objectives to enable overall delivery the project objectives are as follows:

- Delivery of engineering design and documentation to allow successful construction, commissioning and operation of the plant, equipment and support infrastructure within the Project schedule timeframe. The design shall meet or exceed the Company's requirements for long-life, high availability, low maintenance, highly-automated and safe Facilities;
- Providing NTO with infrastructure and plant upgrades that meet the design criteria for the Project;
- Providing NTO with a design that has been rigorously reviewed taking into consideration all process, operational and maintenance tasks;
- Meeting the Projects business objectives.
