Package Name

Repairs, maintenance and servicing of Internal Sewage Pump Stations (“Services”)

Scope of Work

The Subcontractor will be required to conduct quarterly cleaning and servicing, as required by industry/manufacturers standards but as a minimum will include full operational onsite testing of all sewage pump stations that sit inside the fence (internal). At this stage there is one (1) small sewage pump station on the site servicing the security gate house that requires servicing.

The Subcontractor may be required to provide repairs, maintenance and servicing of Internal Sewage Pump Stations on a reactive and unplanned basis as directed by ESS Larrakia from time to time.

Where required, ESS Larrakia will make available to the Subcontractor, potable water, power and ablutions facilities as required to perform the Services at the Client site only. The Subcontractor will be responsible for the removal of all waste generated from its maintenance and repair activities.

This Package is indicative only and subject to change.

Minimum SOW Requirements

All Services will be carried out by competent and qualified supervisors, tradesmen and labourers experienced in Internal Sewage Pump Station works. The Subcontractor will be required to:

1. Comply with all relevant local, manufacturer and statutory workplace health and safety guidelines and standards; regarding the provision of the Services and the operation of any relevant plant and specialised equipment;
2. Ensure relevant inductions and permits to work are obtained and any associated procedures adhered to by it and its personnel;
3. Participate in any workplace health and safety meetings as required by ESS Larrakia or the Client;
4. Develop and maintain Job Safety analysis (JSA) and suitable Safe Work Method Statements (SWMS) to the satisfaction of ESS Larrakia and the Client for each task in each work location as they relate to the Services and operations of any associated plant and equipment and provide all relevant documentation if requested to do so by ESS Larrakia and/or the Client;
5. Provide assistance in relation to workplace health and safety;
6. Provide associated goods and specialist equipment and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as deemed necessary to perform the Services.

The Subcontractor will not be able to outsource any Services.

As part of the tender process the potential Subcontractor will be required to answer an information questionnaire. The questionnaire is provided in the Project Notices Section of the web page.

Delivery / Supply Schedule

It is envisaged the ensuing agreement with the successful party will commence in Q3 2013 and have an initial term of 1 year, with extension options based on performance.
