Project Title: Snowy 2.0 – Future Generation Joint Venture

Project Description: Salini Impregilo, Clough and Lane trading as Future Generation Joint Venture (Future Gen) is a main contractor of Snowy 2.0 EPC Project. The Project is a pumped hydro project that will increase the generation capacity of the Snowy Mountains Scheme by up to 2,000MW and at full capacity will provide approximately 350,000MW/h of energy storage. The project includes all activities associated with the requirements for the Snowy 2.0 Pumped Hydro-electric Scheme.

Opportunity Title: Future Generation Joint Venture (FGJV) would like to engage a company with proven, project Pest & Vermin Control for Camps, Site offices & crib rooms service Site wide for the Snowy Hydro 2.0 Project.

Opportunity Description:

The Subcontractor is required to submit its best proposal in a detailed schedule of rates for the execution of the following scope of work:

The management, control & treatment of pest & vermin at all FGJV properties including but not limited to:

- a. Medical & Dental Facilities
- b. Catering Facilities (including food production & storage facilities)
- c. Accommodation & living facilities.
- d. Working & Office Facilities (within camps & onsite)
- e. Outdoor areas (including BBQ, sporting & storage areas)
- f. General use amenities (including ablution, ice, locker, gymnasiums, taverns & laundry rooms)
- g. Crib Facilities (onsite)
- h. Any or part of the larger construction area that impacts personnel or project requirements.

Species requiring management and/or treatment include but not limited to ants, termites, bees, birds, lice, cockroaches, ticks, dust mites, fleas, flies, mosquitoes, possums, rabbits, feral cats & dogs, foxes, rodents, snakes, spiders, wasps & insect larvae.

The contractor shall deliver the following -

1. Develop a Pest & vermin program (PVP), for all site, to identify problem or potential problem species through pest inspections, treatment schedules (including unscheduled response times) and trend analysis (distribution & abundance) of pest species. This program will be reviewed by the FGJV Environment team.
2. Develop a Pest & Vermin Program (PVP) considering the location & adherence to NSW National Parks & Wildlife guidelines associated to protected species & use of pesticides/insecticides etc. This program will be reviewed by the FGJV Environment team.

3. Provide a pest & vermin plan in line with HACCP requirements associated to kitchens, food service & storage facilities.
4. Provide & maintain appropriate plant, equipment, stores & consumables.
5. Provide (and map) responsive pest & vermin services, including plague activity.
6. Provide expert pest & vermin advice.
7. Provide reports & audits in accordance with legislation & client requirements.
8. The pest & vermin contractor shall work collaboratively with the FGJV Environmental team
9. Provide an integrated pest management system that provides effective pest control incorporating the use of sustainable option, reducing the reliance on chemicals & traps.
10. Provide alternate solutions to the management of pests & investigate approaches to preventative methods as opposed to treatment methods.

Requirements:

FG JV requires Vendor:

- to provide evidence of similar experience in the Business Industry
- to provide evidence of the required government or industry certifications, licenses, associations and/or insurances to deliver the opportunity.
- to comply with all Safety and Environmental Management requirements for the Project. Site Specific Environmental Management Plans will be prepared by FGJV and approved by the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE). The Subcontractor must comply with these plans once approved by DPIE.
- to demonstrate an exemplary safety record and a documented management system for tracking safety performance
- to be financially viable and can demonstrate commercial value.
- to demonstrate a strong commitment to training and retaining a local workforce
- to have an excellent track record in employing and progressing the careers of Indigenous people
- to progressively finding ways to develop the careers of women, veterans, and people with disabilities.
- Treat the environmental they are working in with respect and consideration.

General Information:

FGJV will consider all ICN Registrations where:

- The business demonstrates through their response a clear capability against the key requirements.
- The business completes a response to all Future Gen questions and/or Future Gen documentation
- The businesses ICN profile is up to date and complete.
- The registration is complete prior to any closing date.



- The business operates in Australia and is a registered Australian business.

Local & Regional Content: FGJV strongly encourages businesses who have head offices and/or dedicated premises with the appropriate Local Government approvals from the following regions:

- Snowy Monaro Regional Council Local Government Area.
- Snowy Valleys Council Local Government Area.
- Furthermore, Future Gen strongly encourages Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander businesses to submit applications.
