Scope of Works	
<p>Brisbane Move is seeking for EOIs from suitably qualified companies for the construction of the Depot Power Supply and Depot Fibre Optic Infrastructure at the proposed Depot as part of the Brisbane Metro Project.</p>	

The proposed works are for the installation of conduits and pits for a new Depot Power Supply and Depot Fibre Optic Infrastructure Works in Rochedale. The works are to connect the New Metro Depot to existing power and fibre supplies. Depot Power Supply Infrastructure line is to pass underneath the Pacific and Gateway Motorways and is roughly 2.5km long. The Depot Fibre-Optic Infrastructure follows a separate route and is not required to pass underneath major motorways and is roughly 2km long.

Awarded Subcontractor will be responsible for the whole of the infrastructure scope of works therefore partial scopes submissions will not be considered.

The scope of works comprises, but is not limited, to the following:

General Inclusions

- Subcontractor must ensure compliance with all legislative requirements and conduct work in compliance with QLD and project specifications
- Subcontractor is responsible for the provision and management of traffic, environmental, quality, testing, materials, labour, supervision and safety controls required to complete the work.
- Subcontractor is responsible for the provision and running of site facilities and laydown area

Works

- Utility location and protection
- Relocation of services where necessary
- Dilapidation of the works area and existing services that will be affected
- Renovation of existing conduits and cable support structures along the route
- Trench excavation and backfill
- Temporary works and shoring
- Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD)
- Install of underground electrical and communications conduits and pits
- Reinstatement of disturbed areas including but not limited to road reserve, footpaths, and pavements
- Survey and as-builts
- Testing and commissioning

Exclusions

- Installation of electrical and communications cable for main scope of works
- Test and commissioning of cables for main scope of work
- Connection of cables to any equipment or property for main scope of works

Works are to be conducted in accordance with the Electrical Safety Act 2002 and AS/CA S009:2020 as per TMR Technical Specification MRTS91.

Programme

The works are due to commence in August 2021.
Indicative program duration is between 5 to 6 months.

- **Resources** – Brisbane Move want to ensure that all subcontractors and suppliers are able to fulfil their obligations on time, every time and have the adequate resources for the scope they are tendering for, both in manpower and equipment.
