<p>ICN hereby invites EPC contractors to register for the Expression of Interest (EOI) for the EPC delivery of the North West Queensland Hybrid Power Project (NWQHPP).</p>	
Project Summary	<p>The NWQHPP is a world-first integrated 50MW solar hybrid baseload power plant. The project combines Vast Solar’s modular tower concentrating solar thermal power (CSP) technology with photovoltaic (PV), battery energy storage system (BESS) and gas engine generators to deliver low cost, reliable, clean energy to the Mount Isa region. When completed, the NWQHPP will be the largest hybrid generator and the first utility scale CSP plant built in Australia.</p>
Location of Works	<p>The project is located in the Mount Isa region in far western Queensland. The main NWQHPP power plant site is located 10km west of Mount Isa and will be linked to the North West Power System by a new 220kV high voltage transmission line.</p>
Package Scope of Works	<p>The EPC Package scope is the delivery of the overall project including the CSP, PV, BESS and gas engines plus the access road, water pipeline, 220kV HV transmission line and other associated infrastructure.</p>
Delivery Schedule	<p>The project is currently in the feasibility phase. Financial close is scheduled for Q1 2022, with construction commencing mid 2022 and completed grid synchronisation in mid 2024.</p>
