

MARDIE SALT AND POTASH PROJECT

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Project Overview:

The proposed Mardie Salt & Potash Project (**Project**) is located within Australia’s major salt producing region on the West Pilbara coast. The Project is proposing to be Australia’s first to produce salt and Sulphate of Potash (**SOP**) through the evaporation of seawater.

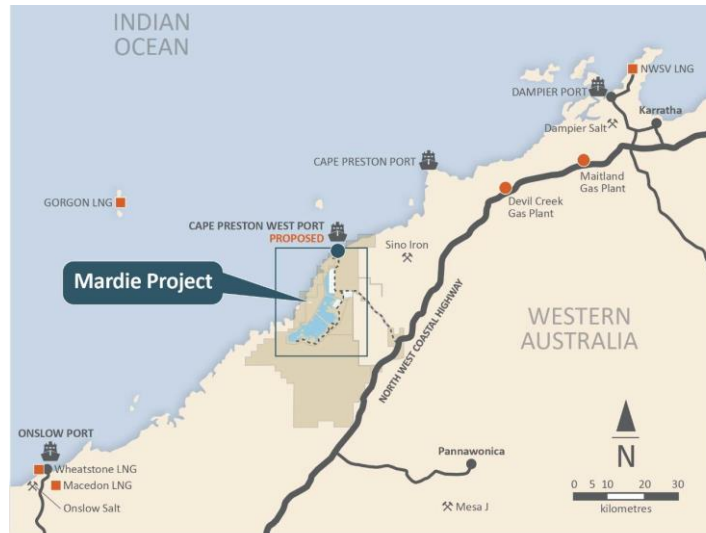


Figure 1 – Project Location

Package Title:

Project Access Roads & Bulk Earthworks

Package Description:

The Scope of Work for the Project access roads and bulk earthwork pads for site infrastructure including:

- Northwest Coastal Highway and Mardie Road intersection (sealed);
- Mardie Road (approx. 20 km of unsealed road);
- Port Access Road (approx. 15 km of unsealed road) c/w access causeway;
- North/South Road (approx. 20 km of unsealed road)
- Village Access Road (unsealed);
- Landfill Road and earthworks;
- Jetty bulk pad earthworks;
- Salt Wash Plant pad bulk earthworks; and
- Pot-Ash pad bulk earthworks.

Scope Requirements:

Contractors wishing to be considered must be able to demonstrate their ability to complete the following tasks:

- Bulk civil and earthworks (approx. 2 million BCM), including permanent and temporary works;
- Construction of Main Roads Western Australia (MRWA) intersections to category R3;
- Traffic management of complex intersections;
- Construction of mine site roads and earthworks embankments;
- Management of water infrastructure including bore pumps, turkeys nests and sea water supply;
- Construction of pavements;

- Supply and install site signage;
- Construction of cement stabilized and concrete floodways;
- Construction of box culverts;
- Construction of HDPE, RCP and CSP culverts;
- Bulk earthworks mass haul planning and management;
- Working in soft soils and experience with clay materials;
- Sorting and processing of construction materials including rock from locally won/ripped material;
- Management of remote batching facility;
- Installation of fencing, gates and cattle grids;
- Working in the vicinity of gas pipeline infrastructure;
- Construction of causeways in soft soils; and
- Civil construction works including piping, underground services, concrete pads, retaining walls and structures.

The works consists of all necessary activities including, but not limited to the following: mobilisation and demobilisation, project management, engineering support and QA management, shire approvals, off-site supply of materials and minor fabrication, transport, supply of all plant and equipment, labour, materials (other than those which the Company may supply).

The works will be “Construct-only” contract with a Company provided commercial terms.
