<p>Scope of Works</p>	<p>Detailed Design, Supply & installation of ICT Infrastructure and systems Including: The core domains of this package include.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Network • Server and Storage • Audio Visual • End User Computing (Desktops, Laptop, printing, scanning etc) • Unified Communications <p>The System Integrator is responsible for the provision of these solutions and if required will sub-contract specialist equipment or services to deliver the required scope.</p> <p>The current QH and Facility networks and existing current state of the broader Logan and MSHHS ICT domains will need to be considered in delivery. The detailed scope and requirements to be delivered under this package will be issued by the Master Systems Integrator, on behalf of the principle.</p> <p>The Contractor would need to demonstrate capabilities of significant ICT hospital build experience, hold all required certifications, and have extensive experience in delivering Health projects within the Queensland Health environment.</p> <p>The proposed scope includes the integration of existing infrastructure and systems in an operational hospital. The scope will include all planning for delivery of works while maintaining operations. The delivery is staged and so consideration of temporary networks, and/or other services will be required.</p> <p>The Contractor is expected to have an experienced team that provide ICT Integration services over and above the simple supply and installation of equipment and systems. 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Project Summary	<p>Logan is one of the fastest growing regions in the state with more than 70,000 additional dwellings expected in the area by 2041.</p> <p>This expansion will enhance the clinical services delivered at the Logan Hospital and improve facilities for patients, visitors and staff.</p> <p>The project includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an additional 195 beds and additional 11 treatment spaces • a vertical expansion of Building 3 (emergency department building), delivering four new floors • building-in of the ground floor of Building 3 • refurbishment of clinical, clinical support and operational service support areas in the other existing hospital buildings.
Location of Works	<p>Logan Hospital Campus is located on the corner Loganlea Road & Armstrong Road, Meadowbrook Queensland 4131, about 29 km South of Brisbane, about 43km East of Ipswich and about 50km North of Southport.</p>
Delivery Schedule	<p>Design Development is currently in progress and is anticipated to be complete by Late 2021. Subcontractor and supplier procurement will commence in August 2021.</p> <p>Early Site works are planned to commence in July 2021. Main works are planned for commencement in October 2021.</p> <p>ICT System Integrator works are planned for commencement in October 2021.</p>
