

Tanami Expansion 2 (TE 2) Project - EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Project Overview: The Newmont Tanami Operation (NTO) is located in the Tanami Desert of the Northern Territory approximately 530 km northwest of Alice Springs. The Brownfields mining operations are located at the Dead Bullock Soak (DBS) area approximately 42 km to the west of the Granites. The nearest settlement is Yuendumu some 250 km southeast of The Granites. The Tanami Expansion 2 (TE 2) Project consists of expanding the mining infrastructure at Newmont Goldcorp Tanami Operations and potential increase of current ore production rate from its current nominal 2.6 Mtpa.

Package Title: **Surface Electrical, Instrument and Communications Works**

Package Description: The scope of this package covers electrical, instrumentation and communications (E&I) installation for the Surface E&I Works. The package includes:

- Installation of buried conduit and cable (11KV Cable, LV cable, Instrument Cable and fibre).
- Installation of above ground cable and supports (11KV Cable, LV cable, Instrument Cable and fibre).
- Cable Splicing, glanding, testing and terminating (including copper, aluminium and fibre core cables).
- Electrical equipment installation and testing – e.g. Kiosk transformers, ring main units, switchboards, PLC remote I/O cabinets and switchrooms electrical installation and testing.
- Instrument installation, calibration and testing.
- Supply of minor instrument and electrical equipment e.g. local control panel, junction boxes.
- Supply of LV, instrument and earthing cables.
- Brackets, poles and lighting installation (lights free issued).
- Supply and installation of earthing and lightning systems.
- Support (Tools, equipment and people) to power up and commissioning of installed equipment.

Contractors are to supply all labour, equipment and consumables to facilitate the works.

In accordance with Newmont's commitments to building local and Indigenous capacity in the region, the tender evaluation will include a weighting for utilising local regional businesses in the Northern Territory.
