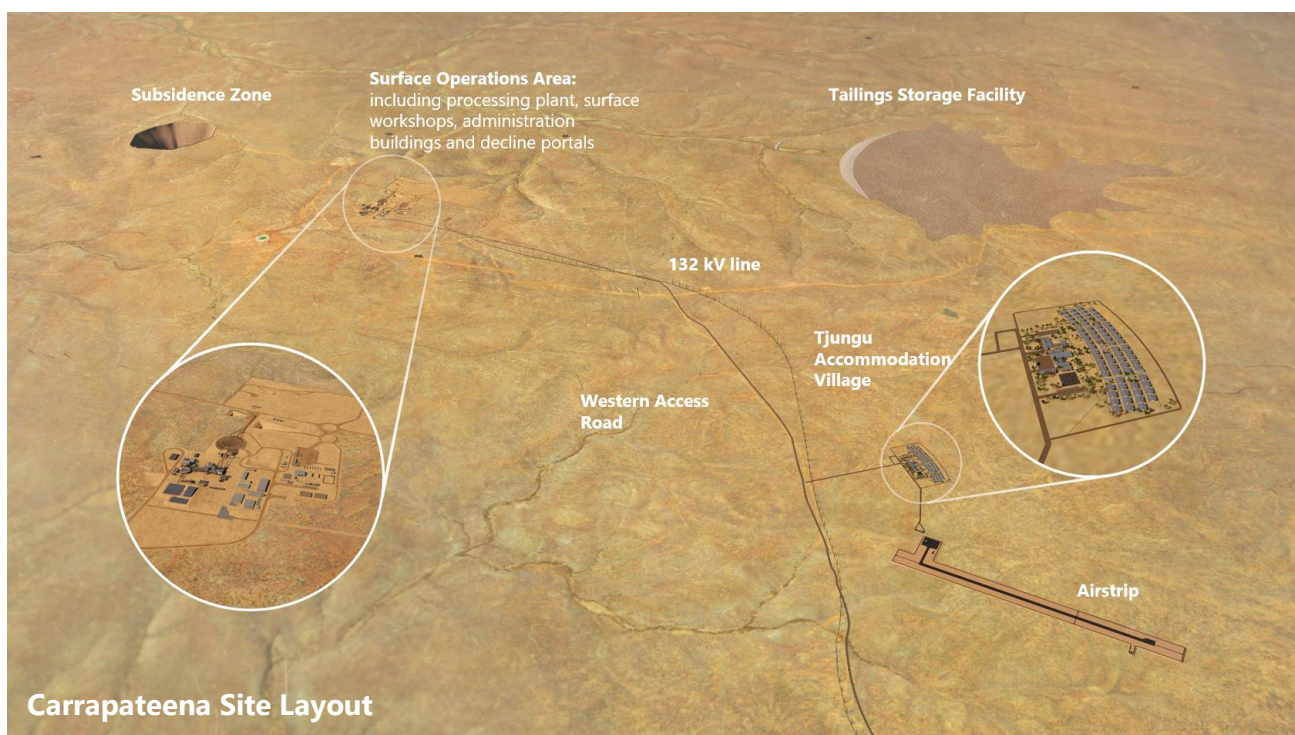
About OZ Minerals

OZ Minerals is an Australian based modern mining company with a focus on copper. Listed on the Australian Securities Exchange, the company has a growth strategy focused on creating value for all stakeholders. OZ Minerals owns the Prominent Hill copper-gold mine and is advancing the Carrapateena copper-gold project. The company has a pipeline of exploration growth opportunities, with the most advanced being the West Musgrave copper-nickel project, currently in pre-feasibility study phase.

The Carrapateena Project

Carrapateena is an iron-oxide copper-gold deposit located in South Australia on the eastern margin of the Gawler Craton. The opportunity is one of the country's largest undeveloped copper deposits and is located relatively close to key infrastructure. It is situated in one of the world's safest mining jurisdictions.

The Carrapateena project will be an underground copper gold mine using a sub-level cave mining method with an onsite processing plant and tailings storage facility. Around 1,000 jobs are expected to be created from construction through to production. Where possible, OZ Minerals is prioritising sustainable local procurement and local employment.



Construction

Construction of Carrapateena is underway and commissioning of the mine is scheduled for Q4 2019 after which the project will ramp up to steady state production.

There are two main phases to construction:

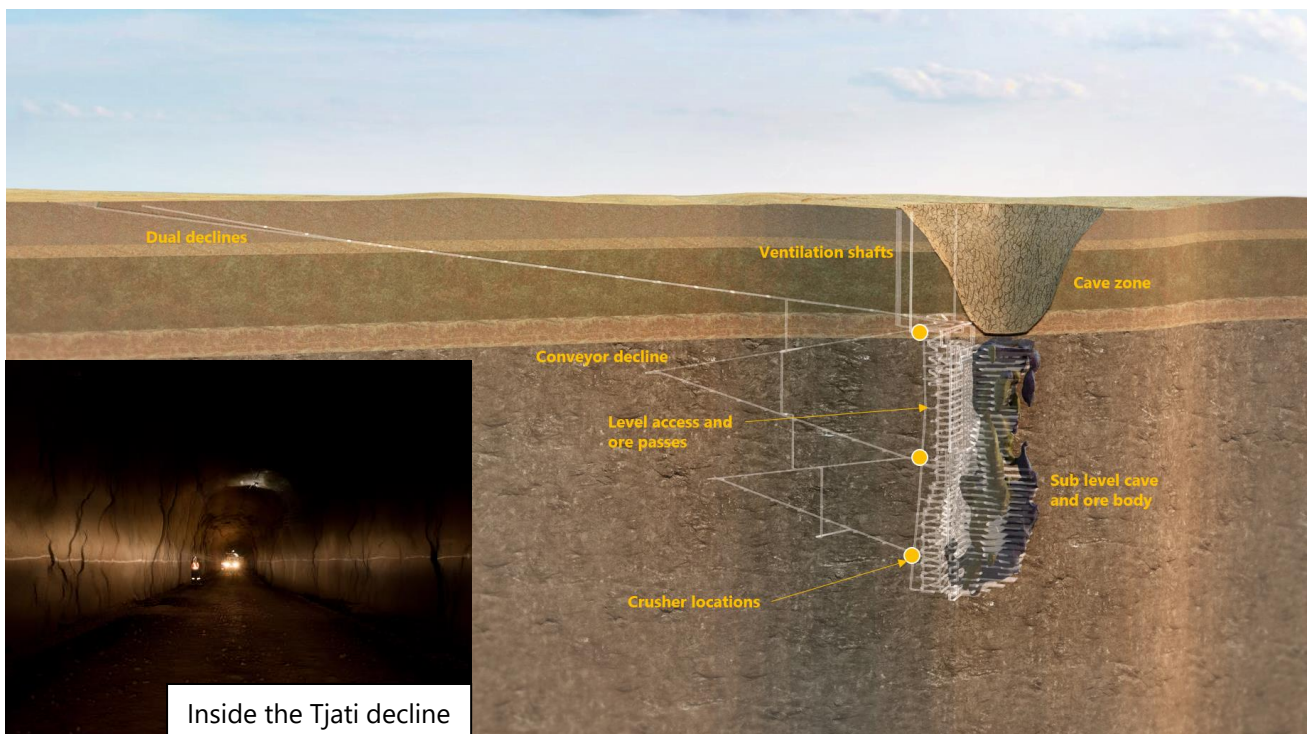
Phase one Q3 2017 – Q1 2018 (underway): construction commences on the accommodation village and airstrip, and development of the dual access decline continues. Construction on the village and airstrip is scheduled to be complete in Q2 2018.

Phase two Q2 2018 – Q4 2019: subject to mining lease approval, phase two includes construction of above ground infrastructure, processing plant, tailings storage facility, western access road, power line and installation of the underground materials handling system.

Lead Contractors

Lead contractors on the project are: **Ausenco Downer (Joint Venture) (ADJV)**, responsible for the delivery of the Minerals Processing Plant, and non-processing infrastructure; **NRW**, responsible for delivery of the Airstrip; **ESMACC**, responsible for the delivery of the Tjungu Accommodation Village; and **ElectraNet**, responsible for the delivery of Regional Power.
